OUR ROOF

The last time the church roof was replaced was 2005. The average asphalt roof lasts 20-30 years. The church roof is inspected regularly and is beginning to show signs that a replacement will be needed in the next couple of years. The Property Committee has been collecting bids for the replacement, and the Finance Committee has identified a grant that might be able to subsidize 50% of the cost. In order to qualify for the grant, our church has to raise the other 50% of the funds needed. We are currently brainstorming fundraising options. Stay tuned.
